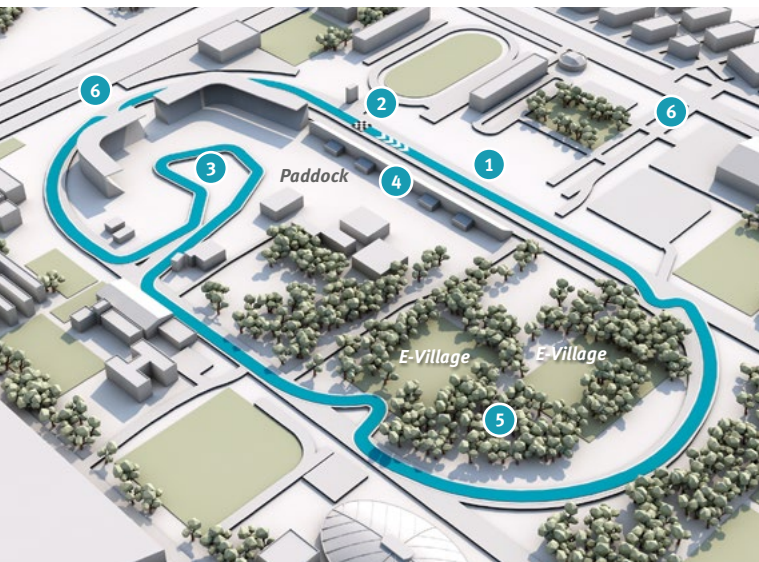

Formula E is now racing in Mexico City for the fourth time since 2015, and once again on the shortened version of the Formula One circuit.

Local mobility

With some 4.2 million automobiles the megacity located on an elevation of 2,310 meters is always exposed to the risk of congestion. Cable cars are efficient mobility alternatives. In 2019, complementing the “Mexicable” system inaugurated in 2016, the second project (“Naucaipan”) will be launched.
